

Course content

The aims and objectives of this course is to provide an insight in the Swedish welfare system, what it is like to live in it and how it came to be what it is today. Theoretical perspectives are combined with more *hands on* information, perhaps useful for those who might be looking into the possibility of an extended stay in the country. You are expected to be able to participate in an educated discussion about, as well as living a comfortable life in, Sweden, by the end of the course. Examples of core topics in class are *the home of the people* (folkhemmet), *the welfare state* (välfärdsstaten) and *gender equality*. Hands on information stretches from *how to get a social security number* (personnummer) and *how to get a job in Sweden* to *what is appropriate or not among Swedes*.

These aims and objectives will be met through fieldtrips to various vital institutions and agencies and guest lectures. All information is presented in English, at the same time as names of institutions, traditions and services etc are exclusively referred to in Swedish.



Week 1.

Monday: Vuxenskolan (Kungsängsgatan 12), 13.45- 16.15.

A broad introduction to the Swedish welfare state, Folkhem and today's political and economic climate. How the Swedish modern welfare state came about and what it is today.

Tuesday: Vuxenskolan (Kungsängsgatan 12), 13.45- 16.15.

A visit from representative of TCO (*Tjänstemännens centralorganisation*), the second largest trade union in Sweden, who will present the labor unions vital part in the forming of the welfare state and its role today.

Wednesday: Vuxenskolan (Kungsängsgatan 12), 13.45- 16.15.

Visit to Länsstyrelsen (The County Administrative Board, the representative of the Government in the region) for information on their organization and especially on their work against discrimination and for gender equality. (We meet at Vuxenskolan and walk to Hamnesplanaden 3 together).

Thursday: Vuxenskolan (Kungsängsgatan 12), 13.45- 16.15.

Visit to Rosendalsgymnasiet, a public high school with strong connections to the university and a well-run example of a public school. Lecture will be held by Siv Inger Halling, lector at Uppsala University who also teaches at Rosendalsgymnasiet. We meet at Vuxenskolan and take the bus to Rosendalsgymnasiet.
